Living Green - Energy: Did you know in winter you can lose a houseful of heat in just two to three hours using kitchen and bathroom ventilating fans? Use them sparingly and turn them off when their job is done. You'll save energy and money. In winter, turn down your thermostat while you're out and at night and save up to three percent on your heating bills.

Living Green— Water: Did you know the average Canadian uses 60–100 litres of water to shower or bathe each day? Take shorter showers and use less water to bath. Collect rainwater for gardening and other outdoor uses. It's that easy! By making small changes in our day to day routines we can conserve water and save money.



Did you know that by simply composting your kitchen waste and refusing flyers and unaddressed mail, you can reduce your household waste by up to 80%?
